### CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION

Schools from Brazil, Chile, Argentina and the USA will be invited. Those responsible for these schools, accepting the invitation, will have their academies registered in the online enrollment system ([www.tatwongbrasil.com](http://www.tatwongbrasil.com)). It is important that the responsible teacher confirm the participation of his school. Only after the confirmation, the school will be included in the system.

**IMPORTANT:** The registration of all the participants must be confirmed by the chief teacher of each school. A checklist with the names of the registered athletes and their respective categories will be sent to the teacher a few days before the event.

### CATEGORIES, REGISTRATION FEES, DEADLINES AND PAYMENT METHOD:

All the prices are showed in Brazilian Reais.

Affiliated schools with the Tat Wong International have a R\$10.00 discount on their registration. You just need to check the box when filling up your registration form on the website.

**For international competitors, the date of the registration determines the amount to be paid. As it is hard and expensive to transfer money to other countries, we expect that the master, sifu or teacher responsible for the school bring the money in cash on the day and site of the event. We will not accept transfers, checks or credit cards. The payment must be made in cash.**

## **FORMS COMPETITION:**

**Beginner:** up to 1 year of training

**Intermediate:** 1 to 2 years of training

**Advanced:** over 2 years of training

**3 Star:** This category is one of the most disputed in terms of technical level, considering this, the organizing committee of the event will only accept experienced athletes, who have already won titles in national competitions. As a matter of organization and logistics, no more than 16 participants in this category will be accepted. The participation will be guaranteed by order of registration, so the first to register will guarantee their right to compete.

## **Group Form Competition**

Group event (jiti 集體) the teams must be composed of at least 4 (four) and at most 08 (eight) athletes. The presentation can be performed with instrumental music, in this case it will be evaluated beyond the synchronism of the presentation movements, the synchronism with the music. The technician of each team will be responsible for bringing his music in mp3 format on a USB stick and coordinate next to the sound table of the event the beginning of the song.

## **Dual Event Competition**

The Dual event (duilian 对练) will be allowed presentations of simulated fights between two or three athletes, with or without weapons, or even using bare hands against weapons.

**UNIFORM:** Pants, belt and traditional kung fu vest. **Martial arts shoes are required only for the advanced category and 3 star.**

**THE RULES** will follow CBKW's Traditional Wushu rule, which is based on the 2012 edition of the Chinese Wushu Association's "Rules for Traditional Wushu Taolu Competition". Available in:

**IMPORTANT:** In case of categories with less than three competitors, athletes can be redirected to the closest categories according to their ages and rankings.

### **3 STAR KIDS FESTIVAL**

The purpose of this festival is to offer to your children, their families and friends fun activities and games based on kung fu. The groups will be separate by age, sex and graduation, with a maximum of six people.

**ACTIVITIES:** Each group will go through a three-station circuit:

**Belt Chase** - Opposition game in which the objective is to pick up the friend's belt.

**Sword Fight** - The goal is to hit the partner's legs with foam sword.

**Form Presentation** - Each participant will perform a kung fu presentation.

Throughout the event there will be a team ready to ensure safety and a healthy environment, which will contribute to a better technical development, in addition to strengthening respect, friendship and responsibility among the participants.

### **SANDA COMPETITION:**

Fights will be matched according to the level of experience, age and weight of the participants. Athletes should fight only once. However, if necessary, categories with 3 competitors will be organized so we can offer the opportunity of participation to everyone registered for the event.

**UNIFORM:** shorts and tank top.

**WEIGH IN:** from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m., at the site of the event.

**MANDATORY PERSONAL EQUIPMENT:**

The two categories of SANDA (Complete Protection and Official) will follow the same official rules used by CBKW that can be found at the link above. The only difference will be that in the Sanda Complete Protection category athletes will use: Chest protector, helmet with grid, shin guard with foot, 10 oz boxing gloves for categories up to 65 kg and 12 Oz over 65 kg.

**The event will provide only GLOVES during the competition, it is responsibility of the athletes and responsible teachers to bring the rest of the equipment.**

**GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS:** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to assemble the matches according to the category divisions, changing them whenever necessary. In practice this means that we can reorganize the weight categories so that the athletes do not go without a matched fight. However, the 5kg difference between one fighter and another will always be respected.

Therefore, it is very important that during the weigh in, the athlete is as close as possible to the weight declared in the registration at the risk of not fighting if the discrepancy is too great.

Omitted cases on this text will be solved by the Organizing Committee during the event.

**3 STAR COMPETITION:**

Traditional 3 Star Competition is a unique and special category, in which the participant is required to present forms in 3 modalities: Hands Form (north or south), Short or medium weapon and long or articulated weapon. The evaluation rules are the same as for individual competition. The result of the athletes is determined by the general average among the 3 averages reached in each category.

## **AWARDS:**

**3 Star Kids Festival:** All participants will receive medals and participation certificates.

**Forms (Taolu / Kati):** medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places (all children up to 12 years of age will receive medals;

**Sanda Complete Protection:** medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd (if any) places;

**Official Sanda:** medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd (if any) places;

**Three Star:** Trophy for the first 6 places and participation medal for all competitors.

Note: All athletes will receive certificates of participation.
